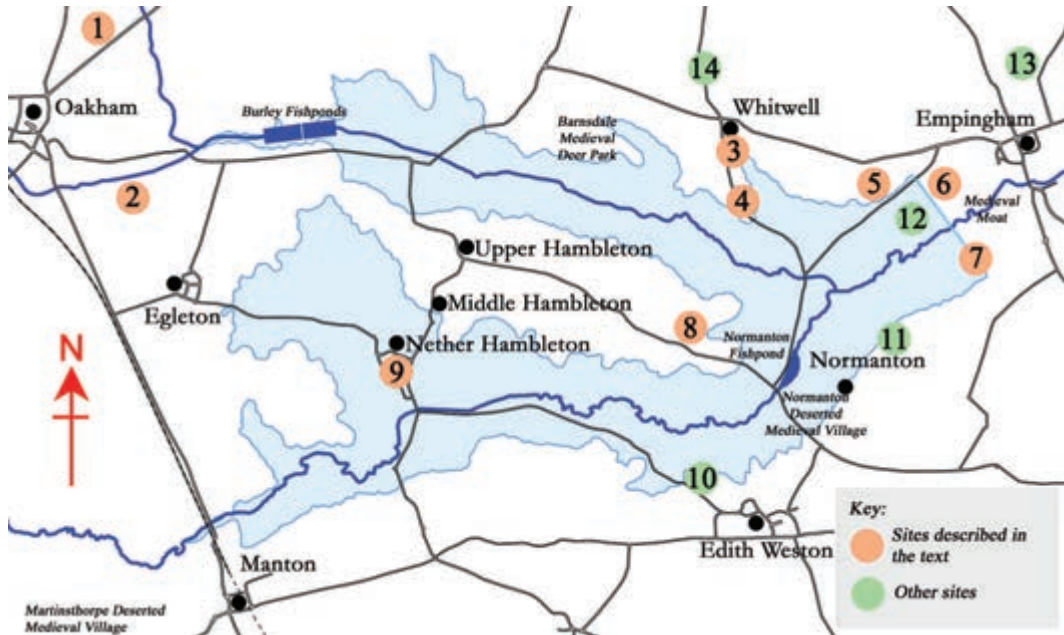


Archaeological Sites in the Middle Gwash Valley



1. Burley Road, Oakham – Neolithic (New Stone Age) pit circle, Bronze age burial and Iron Age enclosure.
2. Oakham bypass route – Bronze Age male burial, ditches and line of pits.
3. Whitwell – Medieval settlement.
4. Whitwell – Iron Age and Romano-British site.
5. Sykes Lane, Empingham – Anglo-Saxon cemetery.
6. Empingham – Romano-British farmstead.
7. Empingham – Romano-British farmstead and Anglo-Saxon cemetery.
8. Hambleton peninsula – Iron Age and Romano-British site.
9. Nether Hambleton – Medieval settlement.
10. Rutland Sailing Club, Edith Weston – Romano-British burial.
11. Renner's Park, Normanton – Romano-British site including a corn drier.
12. Empingham – Iron Age and early Anglo-Saxon settlement.
13. Loves Lane, Empingham - Romano-British site.
14. Whitwell – Roman coin hoard.
