He died in 1570 his successor Leonard Barton being  
 instituted on 9 Mar: ~~whenever~~ during this year the Wardens  
 became aware that 'ther is standinge the foffle of the rooffe  
 Loffe p certain Imaggs in the hofpe of the chancell p the  
 old taper stockes: these are ordered to be removed within three  
 weekes on 30 June.
