No record of any priest in charge of this chapelry during Thickpenny's Vicariate.

In 1576 Francis Pratt did above the V. of O. with well words: viz., saying yt if all covetousnes were lost yt wold be found in you prestes - including p diuine lawe in the chancell at Egleton.

This Ashbrooke is a curacy p seventh if one there p he doth serice on the Sabothay day only p not on the week days p he hath professed to minister the Communion at Eg. if they have the Comm. ministered but once a year unto them p at that time every one wch to receive p they knowe none but wch to receive often yt were offiser ministered unto them receive often yt were offiser ministered unto them

T. A. affeased p shewed a license to serve the Curacy in the absence of the V. of O. granted by Edmund Bp of Pet. - as regard the Communion he has only done it in acc't of the V. on account of the number of communicants 'about 50'. T. A. is warned not to minister sacraments or sacramentals p the V. of O. is ordered to celebrate 4 times a year.
