

Archdeacon Iron's Visitation Notes - Pilton

1355	Nov 04	GDR 101 - At Oakham on the Wednesday after All Saints 29 Edward III Agnes daughter of Robert Guerard of Pilton was charged with burgling the house of the parson of Pilton and taking goods and chattels worth 10 marks, She was found not guilty.
1394	Dec 20	PRO Gaol Delivery Roll:177 Peter atte Well of Edith Weston with Will Hayward charged that on Sunday before Xmas 18 Richard 2 they raped Johanna wife of Will Plainsoyll at Pilton and carried off and stole goods at Will Plainsoyll to the value of 14s. Verdict, not guilty.
1546	to 1582	Wm Laycocke R [Rector] from 1563 82 on presentat [presentation] of James Harrington esq. He seems to be the same who was Cantarist [Cantor - Singer] at Exton from before 1546 & who held the Vicarage of Exton from 1556 65 on [the] presentation of James Harrington esq.
1562		dns [Dominus] [Master] Willinus Smithe Rcor exhi. [Exhibited]
1570		Visitat omnia bene [All went well with the Bishop's visitation]
1570		Mr Draper, Cur [Curate]

1577	May 13	Wm Ireland his tennant is displaced of his seate by one Thomas Wright who kepeth the same
1581	Nov 02	The Wardens of Pilton are presented that their church is out of repayre: the steple is out of repayre, they admit, but not the church: they are asked whether there is certain of the church goods in the hands of Richard ffawkner of Pilton which they admit is the case: whether they have all their bookes appoynted by publique auctie [authority] to be in the church they state that they have all their bookes. The Wardens are admonished that they shall see the steple repayed and certify thereof the first Court after Michelmas next.

1610	May 09	Alice Wilson for being gotten with child in forn [fornication] by one Thomas Wilken who is ###.
1611	Sep 23	Rr [Rector] ffarrington of Pilton paid 3s 4d for his bill
1612	Apl 29	Mr Leycock serveth the curate without licence & is not in orders.
1612	May 30	Mr L hath read prayers at Pilton by the space of a few evenings & mornings being a mere layman.
1612	Jun 13	Mr ffarvington Rector (also Rector of Lyndon) that the curate there is very unofficially served: the church is mucche oute of repayre.
1614	May 18	Wardens present Bill
1614	Oct 12	The church of Pilton is out of repaire by reason of ivy growing on it which rotteth the tymber
1614	Oct 12	There is an ivy that groweth upon the church and causeth the rain to rot the tymber.
1618	Oct 02	Thomas Hewyt cl AB [Archbishop's] licence to serve Curate
1618	Oct 20	Thomas Hewet BA subscribed to the 3 articles on being licenced.
1618		To ask Mr Hunt regarding his Curate there

1620	Jun 19	Roger Cook, Church Warden not certifying of the havinge of a sufficient bible. - They are behind for their booke of christenings pc (excepta est belle. Paid 3s 4d for their book)
1620	Jul 28	Alice Bull to certify penance
1620	Sep 12	I have received of Gorhokes 45s for a bible for the church wardens of Pilton and I am to send presently to Cambridge for the same (? John Lambe)
1621	Apr 21	Wardens did not pay 4d for their othe [oath]
1622	Oct 31	Mr Popely serveth the curate at Pilton without licence
1623	Oct 13	William Tailbie & Alice his wife a.n.f. [Ante Nuptial Fornication]
1624	Mar 08	Abraham Hunt cl AM general licence to preach
1628	Feb 05	John Shelton & Elizabeth his wife ANF [Ante Nuptial Fornication]
1629	Apl	Abr [Abraham] Hunt Rect [Rector] not paying Court fee
1630	Sep 16	Revocation of administration of goods of Elizabeth ffawlknor wid [widow] def. [defunct] proce per Daniel ffawlknor her son def. [defunct] Sarah Gilson to render acet.
1630	Oct 12	John Falkner of Pilton was so drunk on Thursday last Lent or thereabouts he fell down backwards & withal did defile his britches. This was done Nathaniel Bankes at Beho then an alehouse. Witnesses Nathaniel Bankes, Edmund Rudkin.
1630	Oct 14	John ffawlknor rep. Wife of Daniel Gilson of North Luffenham
1631	Oct 17	Rect [Rector] to pay proce: to Archd[n] [Archdeacon] of Northl: [Northampton] Allen R [Rector] cited Wed Nov 3: Jan 31
1631	Nov 03	Sarah Gilson & John ffawlknor: lesram suit: distribution of goods Dec 15
1631	Dec 15	Daniel Gilson & Sarah his wife ga Abraham ffawlknor: ut supra. [as above]
1634	Oct	Abraham Hunt not paying Archdeacon synodals
1634	Dec 04	Kenelm Paine the servt [servant] of the Rector ga John ffawlknor for with holding tithes: & Nov 17 & Jan 22
1635	Sep 17	Par clk [Parish Clerk] yearly appointed
1636	May 12	
1638	Nov 06	Elizabeth Spencer alias Whittle appeared in Whissendine church before Ricahrd Swaine surrogate and purged herself of the crime of adultery. Company: Anna wife of William Cox, Margaret wife of William Wortley, Anna wife of John Walkear, Mary wife of William Walkear.
1647		On the house called the Rectory is a stone inscribed H.A. (Henry Allen) 1647. There was once a stone in memory of this Rector on the South side of the South Aisle under a window inside the church now supposed to be beneath the wooden floor.
1662		Bp's Visit. [Bishops visitation] Rector (? Brown) complp exht bras ord et quoddam scriptum approbat & confirm per Commiss auctorit Parl [Parliament] 1651: necus conficus Justice of Peace 1660 loco Instit: Mr (Richard ?) Browne solv. Ibm lic & lic dicendi apud Pilton.

1662 Geol Deliv R. No. 101 - Agnes dr [daughter] of Robert Everard of Pilton brought before Winge and R [Robert] de Suthcote Kings justices at Okh [Oakham] for burgary of the parson of Pilton where she stole goods and catalls [chattels] worth 10 mks [marks]. Bound over by oath to abide by verdict of jury.

1731 Jun 26 See North Luffenham

1902 Oct 20 Pilton held by dispensation of Frederick Abp [Archbishop] of Cantuar [Canterbury], in union with Normanton
