- 1582 Oct^l Santa Deane is got with child by John Rogerson, 11 Dec a 3 man purg.
- 1587 June 13 John Skellington for going to cart the Sondrae before Micholmas day
- Apr 15 Herbert Floyd R of Stratton: He went with his cart to fetch a load of corn on the Sab. daie: p 5 Dec.

- Jan 29 Henric. Hargreaves R upon Advent Sunday last he was married together with his wife & the parish church of S. George a hyme by laune forbidden. H. admitted that upon this day he married the sd parties but did not know it to be a hyme forbidden by law.

- 1627 Jan 24 M^r Wolstaces R. p John Paine of S: also the Gard: Paine's child Berry at the font to be baptised y^e when the minister was to use the signe of the crose, the sd Paine snatched y^e away And the church warden knowany here of would not present y^e. Paine stated he did request M^r Wolstaces to omit the sign of the crose at whose request M^r W. did omit y^e. M^r W. stated that at the request of the sd Paine he did omit to sign the sd child with the sign of the crose, &c. in omittid that here hereafter he hath use the sign of the crose in baptism.
