- in Feb: High Woods hath not communicated this XII month - belongs to Ryall
- (May 3) They have a booke as: Jewells booke & the paraphrase of Erasmus
- 1581 May
- 1582 Oct. Santa Deane is got with child by John R... 11 Dec a 3 man purg.
- 1587 June 13. John Skellington for going to cart the Sondraie before Micholmas day
- Apr 15 Herbert Floyd R of Stratton: He went with his cart to fetch a load of corn on the Sab. daie: p 5 Dec.

John Clarke: that his cart went forth of the towne with his cart on the Sab. daie, about some battings, he not knowine of it. Note that he wressed his man to go when his neighbours cart went, p 5 Dec.  
 Note that the carts went the Sondraie after the first Radie days  
 John Naylor: likewise, with his cart.

- Jan 14 Rich Ward, a Gard, admit that upon Advent Sunday last he was present in the parish church of Stratton at the solemnization of the marriage - of the sd Naylor & his wife
- Jan 29 Henric. Hargrave R upon Advent Sunday last he was married together Thos Naylor & one Isabel was his wife in the parish church of S. George a hyme by lawe forbidden. H. admitted that upon this sd day he married the sd parties but did not know it to be a hyme forbidden by law.
- 1615 May 11 There churche is oute of repair in slateinge.
- Oct 17 Robt Robinson p Suzan Barlyman for in cont. as the custom fowr south
- 1617 Oct 8 The churchyard wales are in decay and so are the bels.
- Feb 25 Dinother Brown & William Suckling, in cont.
- 1618 April 29 The font waleth a cover & the same will not hold any water but they do use to salt a vason or a board in the font when any child is christened They have 3 bells p but one rope. The glasse windowes are not in good repair (Infern. p. Joh Ashwell & Thilbot)
- 1620 Oct 25 Thos Browne for fyotheringe of a drove of beastes in eveninge prayer time upon the Saboth daye
- 1622 May 8 Thos Browne, Ale house keeper, to certify penance.
- 1632 Oct 30 Same as at Epwelham under same date.
- 1699 Oct 2 To certify a surplice.
- 1627 Jan 24 M<sup>r</sup> Wolstaces R. p John Paine of S: also the Gard: Paine's child Berry at the font to be baptised p when the minister was to use the signe of the crose, the sd Paine snatched it away And the church wardenes knowe any howe of would not presently. Paine stated he did request M<sup>r</sup> Wolstaces to omit the sign of the crose at whose request M<sup>r</sup> W. did omit it. M<sup>r</sup> W. stated that at the request of the sd Paine he did omit to sign the sd child with the sign of the crose, & is omitted that here hereafter he doth use the sign of the crose in baptism.
