Paul Gresham<sup>gent</sup> was charged by the Rector, John Bent, with  
not paying his due tithes. In his first examination he saith

(4)<sup>a</sup> As for paying of anye tithes willowes or thames he saith  
"he never paid anye neither will except he be aduigged by  
"lawe so to do. And as <sup>touching</sup> the sheffe, he hath contended  
"the said parson for the tithes of thaim amonge other things and as  
"for the tithes certified in the ~~libell~~ <sup>libell</sup> he deuided that <sup>the said parson</sup> had anye suche  
"number wherof the said parson shall have had anye tithes And  
"as to saide ~~libell~~ <sup>he saith</sup> he hath satisfied for all amonge other  
"things excepted right or ix<sup>s</sup> which he is vndie at all tymes to give  
"to the saide parson."

(7)<sup>a</sup> ~~The said~~ the said parson hath demanded the said tithes of this  
"respondent if he hath satisfied the same as before"

(4)<sup>a</sup> he hath answered as fullie and playne as he came to the  
"article affer wher he was last exampned as appeareth in the  
"articles <sup>of inquiry</sup> ~~of inquiry~~ that he hath rather paid him more than  
"his duety than lesse & dr. versil deponere de hoc arto.

(5)<sup>a</sup> that there were no such number of Royne as is mentioned in  
"the libell but for those that were he hath abradie satisfied the  
"said parson. And concerning the tithes of the Shepesholde he  
"saith that there is no such custome of paying the monethly  
"plesses if they be sold before maye daie. But as for those that  
"were sold he hath repaid him according to the custome of the  
"saide parish. And also for garden money he saith, <sup>the due</sup>  
"but he hath paid it and also the waxshot he hath paid it." <sup>or dr. versil deponere</sup>

(6)<sup>a</sup> Concerning the payment of thomes willowes, he saith as before.  
"And concerning the marray money and waxshot money he  
"saith he hath satisfied the same parson."

The Churchwardens bring a charge against the Rector, John Bent, which he  
admits to be true. (Charge not specified).  
The Rector states (3) Truth but yes that in the moneth and yere articulate  
"or in any of them he was exampned by vertue of his corporall oth of the  
"truth of the contents of the list of ~~deponere~~ <sup>deponere</sup> mentioned in the said ar  
"titles at which tyme he being seduced by an evell yugende did con  
"traury to his conscience and troth utterly denye the contents of the  
"same. And further he saith, that he the said respondent affer that  
"hysse reformyng to himself and regarding his sentence did confesse  
"the troth ppyably to the surrogate articulate with a corrupt  
"yugende (5) That he believeth that the saide Anne Butler was not  
"with chyldre at the tyme of the saide deprivation and examinacion  
"given and made for she the saide Anne was deliyered about  
"halfe yere before (6) That he hath done very ill in forswearing of  
"himself and therfor reweveth himself to the Lawe and my lord  
"and desired favour"
