- John q. The churchwardens for not calling the people to the Catechisme Mr. Geo Choeeldyce, Kellam Ch., Edward Burton, John Burton, Mance Wilsore. for chiding in the church. Item. Agnes Webster for a brawler with her neighbours Note this byll be not called untill M^o. be at Upppyppan.
- 1583 Apr 8. The parsonage in decay in the ffewois default: 30 Sept, in the pson's default.
- 1595 June 7. John Champion not recg. the Com: these two years or thereabouts neither cometh to the parsh ch. accordy to the lawes.
- 1579 Oct 21. Sr H^o Fitcher pson of our towne the xiii day of September last past being Sunday disturbed my lord Cromwell's chaplain being at his sermone or preaching & said openly unto him that he rayled & that he lacked a benefice Item: These goeth an open Cryme that one Richard ffreaston to have gotten Jone Hargrave his wids with child. Item: the sd Jone Hargrave defameth Jolu Moydes & pulbeth it to him. Item: We find that the parsonage is in decaye & that the pson hath not fully repayed it according to his promise made to my lord Bishop.
- 1598 Jny 15. One Jone Ware servant to Jolu Taylor hath not done any penance for her fornication comitted. Aun ffeston went to Simon Lacye for the lyke offence hath not yet satisfed the congregation by anye penance done. John Jackson & his wife hath not come to the church since Easter, but once himselfe.
- 1587 May 6. Jone Mero went to John Taylor is claphed from her Master one Pordaine in suspicion of being with child but we do not knowe but whether her master knoweth nor howe same
- June 13. Wardens (Parson) reminded that the churchyard is out of repair: p 5 Dec.
- 1586 Feb 11. The Rector hath bene absent from his parsonage two years: the youth are not diligent instructed. James Baines is defamed with the wife of John Fiddle: - suoth. we. J. R. John Wade hath a waide servant gone away with childe. Item: Page: There was a woman went away from being with childe. The wife of Edmund Harrison is a chider & a brawler. Indimagiter. There is a poore woman teacheth under the Curate, not licensed. Nov 22. John Jackson hath one in his house unlawfully begotten with child & will not discover her name.
