Village Hall, Wakerley Road, Barrowden LE15 8EP

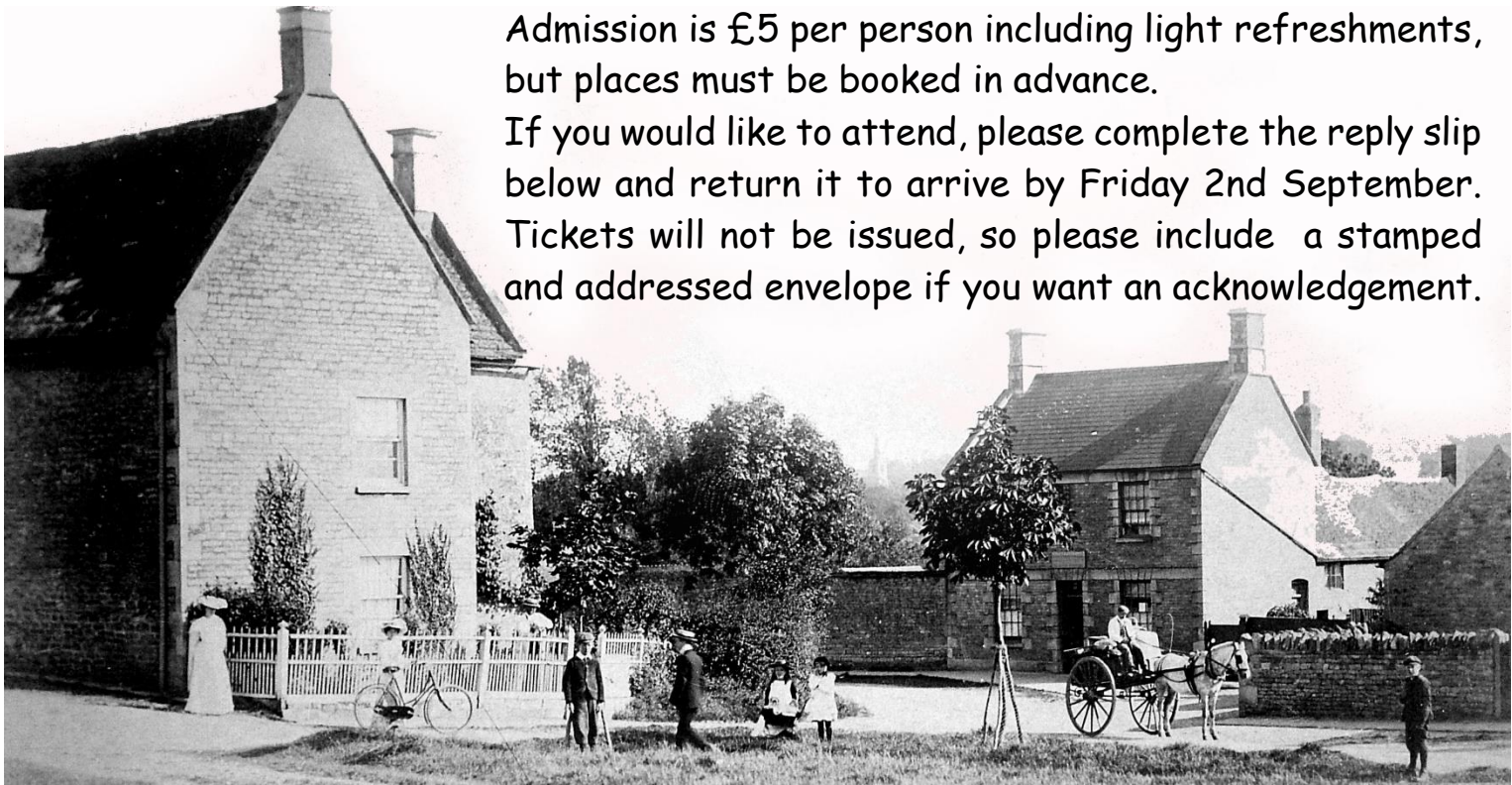
2.00pm Saturday 10th September 2022
